Unless other ise specjed in the regilations to a qualication, the folloting riles ill application to the transfer of credit from one qualication to another qualication, or the sharing of credit (i.e. cross-credit) betilen to qualications.

- (a) An transfer of credit, or cross-credit, to a Te Whare W nanga o Waitaha Uni ersit of Canterb r q ali cation m st meet the req irements of that q ali cation and be accepted b the releant Amo Mat a E ec tire Dean or delegate, in accordance ith CUAP principles and g idelines.
- (b) The letel and amo nt of credit granted for an corse or corses ill be determined by the reletant Amo Mat an Electite Dean or delegate.
- (c) E cept in e ceptional circ mstances and s bject to the rele ant Amo Mat a E ec ti a Dean or delegate s permission, cross-credit and transfer credit ill onl be accepted for co rses completed ithin the time limit of the rele ant q ali cation.
- (d) Unless other ise speci, ed in the reg lations to the q ali, cation, the total credit applied to a q ali, cation from an e ternal credit, incl ding transfer of credit, and recognition of prior learning, ma acco nt for no more than:
  - i. t o thirds of the credit req ired for an indergrad ateq ali, cation; or
  - half of the credit for a grad ate or postgrad ate q ali, cation, and m st not incl de an thesis or research component.
- (e) Unless other ise speci, ed in the q ali, cation reg lations, or an elemption is granted bit the relement Amo Mat a Elective Dean or delegate, the internal credit requirements for quality cations are laid of tin General Conditions for Credit Regulation 12., General Requirements for Credit to be Studied at the Universit.
- (f) E ternal credit ma be Unspeci, ed or Speci, ed.
- (g) Speci, ed credit m st be restricted against a speci, c co rse or co rses.

- (a) A st dent ma appl to transfer credit, either internal or e ternal, from a q ali cation that has not been conferred to another nconferred q ali cation.
- (b) Application m st be made to the Fac lt responsible for the q ali cation recei ing the credit, ho ill be responsible for an approied transfers.

## 7. Cedi i g Mic -cede ia he Qai cai

- (a) In order for a micro-credential to be credited to a q ali cation it m st:
  - i. be certi, ed at Ne Zealand Q ali, cations Frame ork (NZQF) Le el 5 (100-le el) or higher; and
  - ii. be deemed to be appropriate correst at the correct NZQF le el for the qali, cation b the releant Amo Mata Ectie Dean or delegate; and
  - iii. meet the time limit req irements of the q ali cation, nless ai red b the Amo Mat a E ec ti re Dean or delegate; and
  - it satisf the q ali cation req irements as de ned b the reg lations.
- (b) For micro-credentials taken at Te Whare W nanga o Waitaha Uni ersit of Canterb r, there is no limit to the points that can be credited to a q ali cation.
- (c) For micro-credentials from other instit tions, the ma im m credit to a q ali cation is limited as speci ed in cla se 3 (d) of these reg lations.
- (d) A micro-credential can onl be credited to one q ali cation.

### 8. C edif Rec g ii f P i Lea i g (RPL)

- (a) In order for RPL credit to be a arded to ards a UC q ali, cation, the relerant Amo Mat a E ec tire Dean or delegate m st be satis, ed, through an appropriate assessment process, that the st dent has:
  - i. met the learning o tcomes of a specific coorse or coorses at the appropriate NZQF lefel; and
  - ii. met the time limit req irements of the q ali, cation (here the date of the RPL assessment is the date of the RPL credit), nless ai ed b the Amo Mat a E ec ti e Dean or delegate; and
  - iii. satis ed the speci c q ali cation credit req irements as de ned b the reg lations.
- (b) RPL credit ma onl be a arded to ndergrad ate, grad ate, and postgrad ate ta ght co rse ork.
- (c) RPL credit ma be a arded as specified or inspecified credit.
- (d) RPL credit ill onl be a arded for a hole co rse or co rses, and not for indid all assessment items.
- (e) The ma im m credit a arded fla RPL is limited to half the credit of an indergrad ate q ali, cation and one-third of the credit for a grad ate or postgrad ate q ali, cation, e cl ding an thesis or research component, nless other ise speci, ed in the speci, c q ali, cation regulations.
- (f) RPL credit ma be a arded on the basis of assessed formal learning, informal learning, and practical or professional e perience.
- (g) The fee for assessment of RPL is o tlined in the Fees and Fines Reg lations.
