# Fees and Fines Regulations

#### 1.Version

- (a) These equiations came into force on 1 February 2024.
- (b) The pervious version came into force on 1 February 2018.

#### 2. Authority

The Tumu Whakarae | Vice-Chancellor holds authority for these Regulations and in exceptional circumstance on evidence provided, may alter the fees or nes levied on an individual student or vary the fees for a group

- examination period for taught courses.
- (d) A student becmes liable for all fees upon accepting an Enrolment Agreement.
- (e) Tuition fees are due at the beginning of the enrolment period. If the fees are not paid, or suitable payment arrangements made, by the due date noted in the invoice for payment then a default in payment will be registered.
- (f) Whee a student has not accepted their Enrolment Agreement on or before the rst o cial course start date, a late enrolment fee will be applied.
- (g) Whee a pre-enrolled or enrolled student makes an addition to their programme of study then they become liable for the additional fees when the change of enrolment application is approved.
- (h) Whee a student withdraws from a course during the Change of Enrolment period they may become eligible for a full refund of the tuition fees for that course when the change of enrolment application is approved.
- (i) A student must grathe non-tuition fees for speci c courses as set out in ... , 2 , , , , to these (b)

The tuition period ends on the last of the month in which the thesis is submitted or the student withdraws from the course. A student is eligible for a full refund of the remaining portion of their tuition fee for the thesis course in whole months only.

- (c) A student is eligiblerfa full refund for any whole month periods when on an approved suspension of their studies. Application must be made in advance, eligibility for a fee refund for retrospective suspension is no
- permitted unless applied for within the current calendar year and for exceptional circumstances. (d) Students who an approved part-time study for Doctoral, Masters and Dissertation research will be charged at a rate of 65 per cent of the full-time equivalent fee.

#### 5.International Student Fees

- (a) All students fanternational status must pay tuition fees at the international rate, as speci ed in the Schedule to these Regulations, except:
  - whee a student is on an approved reciprocal exchange programme covered by a formal exchange agreement, then they will pay tuition fees to their home university, not to Te Whare W nanga o Waitaha | University of Canterbury; or
  - ii. where they are a PhD student resident in Aotearoa New Zealand, then they will pay the domestic rate for the Research Course.
- (b) A full-be international student who quali es for classi cation as a domestic student, will become eligible for domestic fees from the beginning of their next teaching period or semester (whichever is shorter). A student must:

- i. provide evidence of their changed status prior to the start of the next teaching period or semester (whichever is shorter); or
- ii. in the casefoa research course this will be before the end of any month.

Any potential refund in the di erence in fees (international to domestic) will only be considered:

- a. once the actual Resident Visa is presented to Student Services; and
- will only applyd teaching periods/courses yet to commence.

#### 6. Student Service Levy

A student will pay the compulsory Student Services Levy as set out in Schedule 3: Services Fees, to these Regulations. All Student Services Levy collected is used to directly bene t students.

Students pay an amount per point of study which is capped at 150 points per annum. Distance, Extramural and O shore students are charged at 20% of the full levy fee.

#### 7.Other Fees

A student must pay all other fees as set out in ..., i of these Regulations on a user pays basis for any other goods or services.
