

Postgraduate Certificate in Arts (PGCertArts – 60 points)

These regulations must be read in conjunction with the General Regulations for the University.

1. Version

- (a) These Regulations came into force on 1 January 2021.
- (b) This Certificate was first offered in 2016.

2. Variations

In exceptional circumstances the Amo Matua, Toi Tangata | Executive Dean of Arts or delegate may approve a personal programme of study which does not conform to these Regulations.

3. The structure of the qualification

To qualify for the Postgraduate Certificate in Arts (PGCertArts – 60 points) you must complete the following:

9. Honours, Distinction and Merit

This qualification adheres to the General Regulations for the University, with no additional stipulations.

10. Exit and Upgrade Pathways to other Qualifications

- (a) A student who has completed the requirements for the Postgraduate Certificate in Arts in subjects from Schedule S to the regulations for the Bachelor of Arts with Honours, or in subjects from Schedule S to the regulations for the Master of Arts (180 points), with at least a B average grade in courses for the Certificate, and who has not yet graduated may, provided they meet the requirements for entry, apply to the Amo Matua, Toi Tangata | Executive Dean of Arts or delegate to be admitted to the Postgraduate Diploma in Arts, the Bachelor of Arts with Honours or the Master of Arts (MA – 180 points) and to have courses passed credited to that qualification.
- (b) A student who has graduated with a Postgraduate Certificate in Arts in subjects from Schedule S to the regulations for the Bachelor of Arts with Honours, or in subjects from Schedule S to the regulations for the Master of Arts (180 points) may, provided they meet the requirements for entry, apply to the Amo Matua, Toi Tangata | Executive Dean of Arts or delegate to be admitted to the Postgraduate Diploma in Arts, the Bachelor of Arts with Honours, or the Master of Arts (MA – 180 points), and have their Certificate subsumed in accordance with the General Regulations of the University.
- (c) There are no exit qualifications for the Postgraduate Certificate in Arts.
