Postgraduate Certificate in Arts (PGCertArts - 60 points)

These regulations must be read in conjunction with the General Regulations for the University.

1. Version

- (a) These Regulations came into force on 1 January 2021.
- (b) This Certificate was first offered in 2016.

2. Variations

In exceptional circumstances the Amo Matua, Toi Tangata | Executive Dean of Arts or delegate may approve a personal programme of study which does not conform to these Regulations.

3. The structure of the qualification

9. Honours, Distinction and Merit

This qualification adheres to the General Regulations for the University, with no additional stipulations.

10. Exit and Upgrade Pathways to other Qualifications

- (a) A student who has completed the requirements for the Postgraduate Certificate in Arts in subjects from Schedule S to the regulations for the Bachelor of Arts with Honours, or in subjects from Schedule S to the regulations for the Master of Arts (180 points), with at least a B average grade in courses for the Certificate, and who has not yet graduated may, provided they meet the requirements for entry, apply to the Amo Matua, Toi Tangata | Executive Dean of Arts or delegate to be admitted to the Postgraduate Diploma in Arts, the Bachelor of Arts with Honours or the Master of Arts (MA 180 points) and to have courses passed credited to that qualification.
- (b) A student who has graduated with a Postgraduate Certificate in Arts in subjects from Schedule S to the regulations for the Bachelor of Arts with Honours, or in subjects from Schedule S to the regulations for the Master of Arts (180 points) may, provided they meet the requirements for entry, apply to the Amo Matua, Toi Tangata | Executive Dean of Arts or delegate to be admitted to the Postgraduate Diploma in Arts, the Bachelor of Arts with Honours, or the Master of Arts (MA 180 points), and have their Certificate subsumed in accordance with the General Regulations of the University.
- (c) There are no exit qualifications for the Postgraduate Certificate in Arts.
