2. Variations

In exceptional circumstances the Amo Matua, Te Kaupeka Oranga | Executive Dean of Health or delegate ma approve a personal programme of study which does not conform to these Regulations.

The structure of the quali cation

To qualify for the degree of Master of Counselling a student must:

- (a) be credited with a minimum of 240 points towards the quali cation; and
- (b) be credited with a minimum of 165 points from Schedule C to these Regulations; and
- (c) be credited with a minimum of 15 points from Schedule E Group 1 to these Regulations; and
- (d) be credited with a minimum of 60 points from Schedule E Group 2 to these Regulation; and

4. Admission to the quali cation

To be admitted to the Master of Counselling a student must have:

- (a) satis ed the Admission Regulations for admission to the University; and
- (b) either:

- (a) There are no advancing quali cations for this degree.
- (b) A student who has not met the requirements for the Master of Counselling or who wishes to transfer to one of the following quali cations may apply to the Amo Matua, Te Kaupeka Oranga | Executive Dean or Health or delegate for admission, based on having met the requirements for entry:
 - Postgraduate Certi cate in Counselling Studies;
 - ii. Postgraduate Certi cate in Education;
 - iii. Postgraduate Diploma in Education;
 - iv. Postgraduate Certi cate in Health Sciences;
 - v. Postgraduate Diploma in Health Sciences; or
 - vi. Master of Education.
