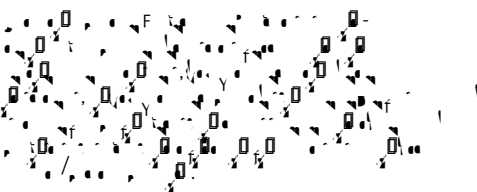

Certificate in University Preparation (CUP)

1. Purpose of the Certificate

The Certificate in University Preparation (CUP) is designed to provide students who have not completed Year 12 of school with the opportunity to gain the necessary academic skills and knowledge to enter a degree programme at the University of the West of Scotland.

2. Certificate Programme

The Certificate Programme consists of four semesters of study. The first two semesters are dedicated to the study of English and Mathematics, while the final two semesters are dedicated to the study of a chosen subject area.

3. Admission Requirements

Students applying for the Certificate Programme must have completed Year 11 of school with a minimum of 60% in English and Mathematics. Students who have completed Year 12 of school with a minimum of 60% in English and Mathematics may also apply.

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Note: Year 12 applicants who have been out of school for less than one school term, including those who have left school at the end of the previous year, may be considered, normally subject to the support of their former school principal. Year 13 applicants who apply during the course of their Year 13 year may also be considered, normally subject to the support of their former school principal.

4. Requirements for Credit

Students who complete the Certificate Programme with a minimum of 60% in English and Mathematics will be awarded a Certificate in University Preparation. Students who complete the Certificate Programme with a minimum of 70% in English and Mathematics will be awarded a Certificate in University Preparation with Honours.

Students who complete the Certificate Programme with a minimum of 80% in English and Mathematics will be awarded a Certificate in University Preparation with Distinction. Students who complete the Certificate Programme with a minimum of 90% in English and Mathematics will be awarded a Certificate in University Preparation with Merit.

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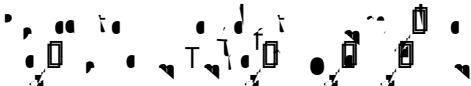
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
