You will need:

- Your Apple or Android mobile device
- Your computer
- A good internet connection
- Your work email address and password.

To get started:

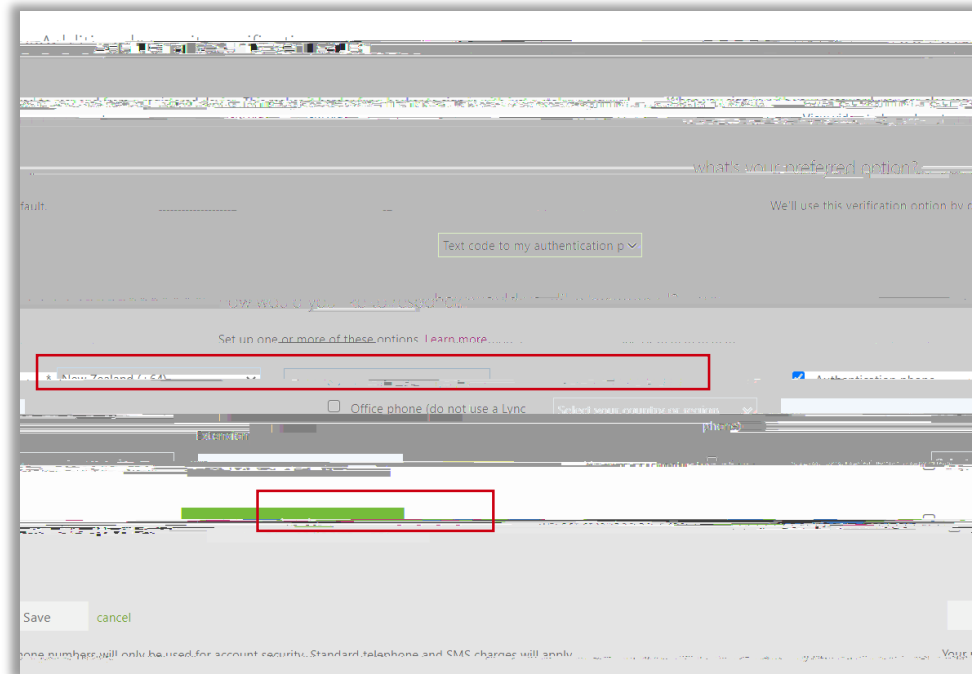
You will need to have an authenticator app downloaded **Installing an Authenticator App** guide.

1. Go to <https://aka.ms/MFASetup>.
2. Choose your preferred authentication method and enter your phone number.
3. Select **Set up Authenticator app**.

4. A QR code will appear for your mobile configuration.

5. Open your Authenticator app.
6. Select **Add work or school account** and click **Next**.
7. Use the camera on your phone to scan the QR code.
