



BCom – Taxation & Accounting Major for CA ANZ

- To graduate with a Bachelor of Commerce you must meet the degree requirements as follows:
- i. To qualify for the degree of Bachelor of Commerce a candidate must pass courses having a minimum total value of 360 points.
 - ii. Of the 360 for an Accounting Major
 - (a) At least 255 points must be from the Schedule of Courses for the Bachelor of Commerce; and
 - (b)

or minor.

Typical degree structure:

- x 135 points at 100 level
- x 135 points at 200 level (if you take additional at 200 level you can take credits at 100 level)
- x 90 points at 300 level (if you take additional at 300 level you can take credits at 200 or 100 level)
